During 1980, 297 organized groups comprising 19 028 Black pupils, mostly from the Orange Free State but also from Lesotho, Bophuthatswana, Qwa-Qwa, and northern Cape visited the National Museum. Other visitors also included members of various church congregations and parents. In recognition of the excellent educational services rendered during these visits, the schools of Popa, Lesotho and Kortlaagte, Dover, presented the National Museum with beautiful handcrafts.
