Jacobus Gideon Nel Strauss was born in the Calvinia District of the Cape on 17th December, 1900, received his education there and at the University of Cape Town, where he graduated as B.A. and LL.B. in 1922. In 1923 he became private Secretary to General Smuts who was then Prime Minister. Upon the accession to power of the Nationalist Party in 1924, Mr. Strauss became Registrar to Sir Etienne de Villiers, at that time Judge President of the Free State Division of the Supreme Court. 1)

Admitted to the Bar in 1926, Mr. Strauss practised as an advocate in Johannesburg and entered politics, becoming a member of the Transvaal Provincial Council in 1929, and Member of Parliament for the Germiston constituency in 1932. In the general election of 1933 he was returned unopposed, being re-elected in 1938, 1943 and 1948. 1)

In March, 1944, Mr. Strauss attained Cabinet rank as Minister of Agriculture. He succeeded General Smuts on 14th June, 1950 as Leader of the Opposition in the South African Parliament. After General Smuts' death later in the year, he was elected Leader of the United Party. He occupied this position until November 1956, when he was succeeded by Sir de Villiers Graaff. 2) After his political retirement, he went farming. 3)

Mr. Strauss married Miss Joy Carpenter in 1928 and they have four children.

3. THE DOCUMENTS AND THEIR ARRANGEMENT

3.1 ORIGIN

The collection was handed over to the Institute for Contemporary History in two installments by Adv. Strauss during 1976 and 1978.

3.2 ARRANGEMENT

The documents of Adv. Strauss are fairly complete and reflect his political activities.

The collection consists of subject files and a few loose documents, but general files also exist. A subject classification is maintained, with an indication of the kind of material for each file. Where possible, series are divided into sub-series to assist the researcher. Files of clumsy proportions are subdivided and to facilitate the determining of accessibility, the numerous clippings, which are readily available, are pooled together in such subdivisions.

General files and loose documents are sorted in series according to the kind of document.

In all cases documents are arranged chronologically within each series. Undated papers have been placed at the end of each relevant subject. General clippings, photographs and publications, not part of the subject files, are indicated in appendices A-G.

4. EXTENT AND CONDITION

This collection is in very good state of preservation and occupies 5m shelving space.
